AIBL Chapter of Year Competition GUIDELINES

1. The PowerPoint Presentation and Registration Form are due **March 26, 2010**. PowerPoint Presentations may be e-mailed or sent through the U.S. Postal Service. If your presentation is too large to email, you must mail a CD or USB thumb drive postmarked before the deadline. It is your responsibility to verify that we receive your PowerPoint Presentation. Please be sure to label files with the name of your chapter. It is difficult to differentiate between files that are labeled "AIBL Presentation, for example.
2. Your chapter must have a current **Application for the Establishment of an AIBL Chapter** form or a **Renewal of AIBL Chapter Status** form on file at the National AIBL Office.
3. Each chapter registered for the AIBL Chapter of the Year competition will be given a total of twelve minutes to do a presentation on their chapter. A time keeper will notify you at the two minute remaining mark. When your time is up your presentation must stop.
4. The presentation must be done in Microsoft PowerPoint Presentation format. No other formats will be accepted. A laptop computer and LCD projector will be provided. Due to limited time your chapter will not be allowed to use your own equipment.
5. The presentation must include the following: Chapter Name, Current Chapter Officers (Names & Titles), and Current Chapter Advisor(s). Chapters will be judged on current & past events/activities, community service projects, chapter run small businesses, group dynamics, collaboration with other AIBL Chapters, unique activities or projects, participation in national conference, fundraising, and presentation skills. During the AIBL Conference, chapters will earn additional points for being present during morning roll calls and workshops.
6. A panel of entrepreneurs, financial professionals, educators, and tribal leaders will judge the competition.
7. The competition will be separated into the following categories:
 - K-8
 - High School
 - Tribal College & University
8. Cash prizes are awarded for first place in each category. Chapter presentations are scheduled to take place on the first day of the Conference, times to be announced. Your chapter will be randomly selected to present. Winners will be announced at the Conference awards banquet.
