APPLICATION FORM

This award recognizes an AIBL advisor who has made himself or herself available to support the activities and efforts of the student chapter. The student chapter members must view this person as going above and beyond what is expected of an advisor. One AIBL Advisor of the Year Award will be given to a high school advisor, tribal college advisor, and a university AIBL advisor.

The person who is selected as "AIBL Advisor of the Year" will receive:

- An "AIBL Advisor of the Year" Trophy
- A One Hundred Dollar Cash Prize
- Leadership Conference Awards Banquet Recognition
- National Recognition on www.aibl.org

Application Procedures

1. A letter of nomination written and signed by the AIBL Chapter member(s).
2. A brief biography (no more than two pages) listing the activities of the nominee, including their achievements, awards, and accomplishments. These activities must demonstrate how the nominee's support and commitment has impacted AIBL student activities and the AIBL program as a whole.
3. Chapters are welcome to submit additional information such as letters of support, news clippings, and photos as desired. All information submitted should be presented in a neat, organized, and professional manner.
4. All applications become the property of AIBL, and will be stored in the AIBL archives after they have been reviewed. A committee appointed by the AIBL Board of Directors, with final approval by the Board of Directors, will judge applications. Chapters will be notified of application deadlines and award winners.
